### Parent Child Interaction Therapy

Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) is a short-term, specialized behavior management treatment that has been shown to reduce children's disruptive behavior and improve the parent child relationship.

Parents and children go through a series of sessions with a qualified therapist who helps the parent reinforce correct behaviors of their child while the parent and child are engaged in play.

PCIT works with the child and parent together to improve overall behavior and to reduce parenting stress.

PCIT is offered to families with children 2-7 who do not have OHP and who would otherwise not be able to get this treatment. It is also available to families with OHP

## **Goals of PCIT:**

- Improve the parent-child relationship.
- Improve your child's minding and listening.
- Increase your child's ability to manage frustration and anger.
- Increase you child's appropriate social skills
- Improve your child's attention skills.
- Build your child's self-esteem.
- Build parent's self-confidence.
