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

The OSU Child Development Center provides a high-quality preschool program for all children in the community and has done so since 1926. We help children explore their world through purposeful, developmentally appropriate play, which allows them to develop skills and potential for future learning. We have three bright and accessible classrooms, and each has an observation room for parents to watch their child at work and play. Children spend time every day in a fenced, supervised play yard for outdoor activities.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Our curriculum focuses on your child's development and preparing him or her for kindergarten. We offer a developmental and individually adapted curriculum that guides children to acquire learning readiness skills. Activities build on each child's interests by introducing increasingly complex opportunities for exploration to enhance knowledge, promote development and support kindergarten readiness.

Focus areas include:

- Social skills and self-regulation (self-control)
- Fine and gross motor skills
- Cognitive problem solving
- Language and pre-literacy
- Creative expression

Eligibility - Children must be at least 3 and no older than 4 by September 1 of the year they enroll.

Placement - We serve 58 children. Applications are accepted all year. There is no cost to apply.

Class groups - Children are placed in mixed-age class groups of up to 20 children each.

Field trips - We offer a variety of field trips and invite parents to participate and assist.

Campus parking - Parents receive short-term passes to park in designated spaces during drop-off and pick-up times.

Transportation - We don't have a school bus. Talk with us about transportation options.
