

Siletz Tribal Head Start

The Siletz Tribal Head Start Program offers a developmentally appropriate and Native American culturally relevant preschool experience. Our program supports the individual growth for each child and focuses on activities to promote school readiness skills. The Siletz Tribal Head Start program also extends services to support the families of the children and offers parent skill building activities and family support services that are responsive to their needs.

The Siletz Tribal Head Start Program is FREE to qualifying families.

We are accepting application for the children who will be ages 3 or 4 years on or before September 1st. A preference for enrollment is given to children and families for the following: Siletz Tribal members and descendants and other enrolled Native American children and descendants (you do not have to be Native American to attend our program), Children returning for a second year of services. Low-income households, Children identified as special needs, 4 year olds, Child/Family was a participant in the Siletz Maternal Home Visiting Program, Single parent households, Child is a victim of abuse or neglect, Child has a non-handicapping condition, Child had a sibling that attended our program, Child is living in an out-of-home placement, Households at 103% of Poverty Level Income.
